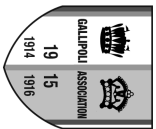

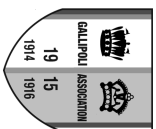

### The Direct Debit Guarantee

- This Guarantee is offered by all Banks and Building Societies that take part in the Direct Debit Scheme. The efficiency and security of the Scheme is monitored and protected by your own Bank or Building Society.
- If the amounts to be paid or the payment dates change The Gallipoli Association will notify you 30 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed.
- If an error is made by The Gallipoli Association or your Bank or Building Society, you are guaranteed a full and immediate refund from your branch of the amount paid.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by writing to your Bank or Building Society. Please also send a copy of your letter to The Gallipoli Association.

## Members are able to pay their subscriptions by one of the following methods:

### Direct Debit:

Please complete the Direct Debit Mandate overleaf and return it to the above address. **This is our preferred method of payment.**

### Cheque:

Cheques should be made payable to **The Gallipoli Association** and sent to the above address. It will still be possible to pay by cash but we strongly discourage members from doing this as it is not a secure method of payment.

### Paypal/Credit card:

This mechanism for signing-up and payment requires either that you have an existing Paypal account, or that you are willing to create one at the time that you join.

Connect to the Association's website at <http://www.gallipoli-association.org>. At the 'Membership' screen, select your category of membership, either 'UK' or 'Overseas', and follow the on-screen instructions. You will be asked to provide your personal contact details and to choose a username. You will then be taken to the secure Paypal screen where you can make payment either directly from your own Paypal account, if you possess one, or otherwise by credit card, which will entail creating a Paypal account. You will subsequently be contacted by the membership secretary who will confirm your membership and allocate you a password which will allow you to log in to the members section of the website. Please note that a small fee is levied on top of the subscription amount to offset the costs of providing this payment service through Paypal.

The process described above is solely for new memberships. Existing members should not 'renew' via this mechanism. Each year, Paypal will issue an automated email giving notice that they will shortly be taking your subscription payment. You need take no further action unless you wish to unsubscribe, or if the subscription rate is changed, in which case the Association will supply step-by-step instructions.
